 - E. IHSAA Assistant Commissioner comments – Sandy Searcy – shared IHSAA proposals that will be voted on at the 2015 IHSAA Board of Directors Annual Meeting on May 4, 2015. Highlighted areas of interest were three courses that all coaches must complete three education courses and be accredited prior to their season or coaching responsibilities (grades 9-12). Two of the courses are Concussions in Sports and Heat Illness Prevention (free courses). The third course being an IHSAA approved sport specific course (\$50-70 fee) with the question being who will pay for this course. Other areas of interest that were discussed: fining of the school instead of an athletic team forfeiting a game due to an unlicensed official being used in contest, limiting non-football team sports summer activities, reducing the number of volleyball matches to 22 and 2 tourneys, and allowing freshmen games to end in a draw if approved by both teams prior to the match. Sports chairs and liaisons were encouraged to attend this upcoming meeting to voice concerns and show support. The IHSAA needs to approve a by-law in reference to the education of coaches to keep sports control in the hands of the IHSAA in lieu of the state legislature.

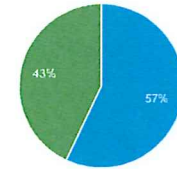
